The attraction Christians have for the teaching idea of Africans Teaching Africans is amazing. This photo, of one of our classes was taken in India. Notice that almost everybody is African. The Africans are from South Sudan and they are university students in India. They are Christians and who learned about our teaching idea through Pavan Ron (in the blue striped shirt). So, they started an ATA class in Hyderabad, India.

Sadly, these students are now stranded in India. They are part of a group sent at government expense to attend university in order to obtain an education in skills much needed in South Sudan. Their government has stopped supporting these students so the students are not allowed to go to class and they aren't receiving help for their living expenses.

Please pray for these students. They need money to stay in India. Returning to South Sudan is frightening because of the vicious genocidal war currently taking place there (even if they had air fare). There are 13 Christians who have requested financial help so that they can eat.





Above is a photo taken at an ATA class in Malawi. Please pray for the man in the middle. His name is Chipembedzo Cha Makolo. He is a cult leader of African Tradition Religion, and he has been attending ATA classes faithfully since it started. I ask you to join me in prayers for the Lord to open the heart of this man to Christ. He has started making Christ-centered prayers.

We hope that, by attending our classes, he will soon leave the traditional religion behind and become a born again Christian. His conversion would speak loudly to his current followers.

Abraham Kogo delivered 89 Nuer language Bibles to happy ATA students in the camp.

This photo is of a very important trench. It is slowly being hand dug, and when finished it will deliver fresh water to a part of Bweyale refugee camp. Currently the inhabitants of the camp have to walk miles and wait in long lines to get their water.



The fierce war in South Sudan is causing over 10,000 refugees per week to flee to Uganda. Around 72% of the refugees are children. It is heart breaking to see the suffering.

We plan to visit this refugee camp in a couple of weeks. We want to check on the progress of the water project which will help us determine if we should start another one to a different part of the camp. One of our supporting churches has donated enough money to install two water taps.

There is a lot of misery in the world especially in Africa. We see extreme poverty and it is especially sad because it is caused by sin. Much of Africa has been blessed by God with all that is needed for people to live good lives. The problem is that a few people steal all they can and little is left over for everybody else. South Sudan is a center for extreme suffering caused by the genocidal tribal war between the Nuer and the Dinka tribes. They kill each other just because they have always done this.

The only cure for Africa is the spreading of the gospel. Currently there are many missionaries working to do this, but we need more, especially someone to replace us.

We hope to be in the United States for a short time between September 16 and November 9. This trip is mostly for doctors' visits and to visit supporters we were unable to visit last year because of illness.
